As a youth volunteer, I will help kids to learn how to live with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, endurance, forgiveness, and love. Therefore, my conduct will be Christ -like.

To be an effective Christian role model, I agree to dress modestly and appropriately for our church setting and have the freedom to interact with the children no matter what activity they are involved in.

Modest and appropriate dress is defined as shorts or pants (no skirts) - length being mid-thigh or below (short length must be <u>no shorter</u> than the tip of your finger when your arm is <u>straight</u> at your side), not extremely tight, and no showing of buttocks, cheeks, or underwear when standing or bent over; if hip-hugging pants are worn, the shirt must overlap the top of the pants even when bending over. Shirts/blouses - must completely cover the chest, midriff, and stomach, be made of non-see-through fabric, and with no obscene or rude language and/or advertising, have sleeves or wide shoulder straps (no tank tops or muscle shirts).

Cell phones will be in the off or non-audible setting and only used in case of an emergency; this goes for text messaging as well!

The Vacation Bible School leadership staff reserves the right to ask anyone dressed or behaving inappropriately to leave their area of assignment and to call for a ride home.

I will be ready to help each day from June 10th through June 14th from 8:30 a.m. until 12:15 p.m. and **attend all required training and planning meetings and set-up (June 6-8)** <u>unless</u> <u>cleared with the VBS Director beforehand</u>. Unfortunately, students must be moved to a waiting list if this is not done.

Training meetings will be held on **May 18th from 9:00 a.m.-Noon <u>and</u> June 7<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m.,** both at the church.

All youth volunteers must be picked up by **12:30 p.m.** unless they are working with their assigned teacher(s).

I understand that Riverside Baptist Church **will do its best** to accommodate my preference, but I know **LAM NOT GUARANTEED** to be placed where I have requested.

I also understand space is limited and that no placement will be considered until this completed and signed form has been returned to the church office or Vacation Bible School table on Sundays.

Youth volunteers start at completed 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
